Of solace, peace, and rest.

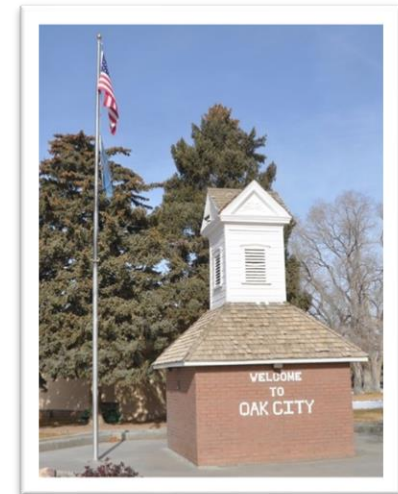
Search the world o'er and o'er
